

“Win a Camper Trailer Promotion”

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to QUEENSLAND (QLD) VICTORIA (VIC) SOUTH AUSTRALIA (SA) residents who are licensed electrical contractors or are an account customer of participating Sherriff branches that displays promotional advertising featuring this promotion (“Eligible Entrant”). Local State and Federal Government departments, institutions and cash sale customers are excluded. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, participating Sherriff branches and agencies associated with this promotion are also ineligible to enter.
3. Any Eligible Entrants under 18 years old must have parental/guardian approval to enter and further, the parent/guardian of the entrant must read and consent to these Terms and Conditions.
